
Action Taken Report on Feedback from Students During the collection of feedback from the students of 2017-18, they were asked various questions related to the curriculum, facilities, and guest lectures. The students of the college expressed their satisfaction levels which were 60%, 70%, 50%, and 70%, respectively. After analyzing the feedback, it was decided that the management and principal needed to take cognizance and improve the curriculum design to make it more job-oriented. Therefore, the faculties of our college who were working in the board of studies and syllabus design were conveyed the expressions of the students. Regarding the second and third questions, 60% of the respondents expressed their satisfaction, and the remaining 40% indicated the need for improvement in the area of employment and placement. In the case of the fourth and fifth questions, students expressed their complete satisfaction at 70%. Additionally, 60% of employers showed high satisfaction with the planning and organizational skills of the faculty. Unfortunately, for the third question regarding the ability to use technology, no employers expressed satisfaction. However, 60% of employers stated that they were happy with the ability to contribute to the organization's goals. The feedback committee gathered responses from alumni for the academic year 2018-19 and the participation was very enthusiastic. About 50 alumni were given feedback forms to fill out. After the data was collected and analyzed, the committee drew some conclusions. When asked about the relevance of the curriculum and whether it is job-oriented, 70% of the alumni agreed that it met the demands of the students. In terms of infrastructure, lab, and library facilities, 60% of the alumni were highly satisfied, whereas 10% of them were dissatisfied. When asked if there were proper arrangements for guest lectures at the college, 70% of the alumni expressed their high satisfaction. Regarding the cooperation they received from teachers, library, and office staff, 64% of the alumni were highly satisfied, 26% were satisfied, and 10% were neutral. When the alumni were asked about the availability of faculty members on campus during duty hours, they expressed mixed opinions. The analysis of these results led to the decision that the availability of faculty members for alumni during duty hours is just as important as it is for current students. Faculty members and non-teaching staff were informed about this message and the importance of providing proper cooperation to alumni as well.

Action Taken Report

Based on feedback collected from teachers of a college, an analysis was conducted regarding the syllabi taught by teachers. Five questions were asked, including whether there is a good balance between theory and application, if the objectives of salary are satisfactory, whether infrastructural facilities are up to par, if adequate opportunities and support are provided for upgrading skills and qualifications, and whether the environment in the college is conducive to teaching and research. The teachers expressed varied opinions on these issues. 60% of teachers were satisfied with the balance between theory and application in the syllabi, while 40% were pleased with the objectives of salary. Moreover, 60% of teachers were content with the infrastructural facilities provided by the management, and 80% expressed their happiness with the adequate opportunities and support given for skill and qualification upgrades. However, only 33% of teachers expressed happiness with the environment in the college that is conducive to teaching and research.

Considering the lower percentage regarding this issue, the feedback committee has decided to convey the teachers' problems to management so that the issues can be resolved in time.

Students' Feedback 2019-2020





In 2019-20, feedback was collected from students regarding the syllabus, which encompassed five different areas of inquiry. These included the level of interest and ease of understanding of syllabus material, the degree to which it was applicable to life situations, its adequacy in promoting scientific analytical power and addressing social and linguistic concerns, and whether it was sufficient in promoting ethical, moral and professional values. 60% of students expressed satisfaction with the inclusion of interesting and easy topics in the syllabus, while 40% expressed satisfaction with its relevance to real-life situations. In contrast, 60% of students expressed complete satisfaction with the syllabus' emphasis on ethical, moral and professional values. When it comes to the depth of course content, 40% of students expressed happiness. However, a mere 20% of students expressed satisfaction with the syllabus's ability to foster analytical power in regards to social and linguistic issues. Consequently, there is cause for concern regarding whether the objectives of the curriculum are being met for the students. There is a need to ensure that students are made aware of and equipped with the ethical, moral, and professional values outlined in the syllabus.

Action Taken Report

During the feedback collection for the year 2019-20, employers were asked five questions related to working as part of a team, planning and organizing skills, ability to use new technology, ability to contribute to organizational goals, and relationships with senior and subordinate faculty members. The responses varied for each question. For the first question about working as part of a team, 80% of employers were satisfied, while only 20% expressed satisfaction with the planning and organizing skills of the faculty. Regarding the third question about the ability to use new technology and workplace equipment, 80% of employers were pleased. For the fourth question about contributing to organizational goals, 80% of employers expressed satisfaction, but only 40% were satisfied with the relationship between faculty members and their seniors, peers, and subordinates.

After analyzing the feedback, it was determined that a meeting should be held to present the results to all staff members. The issue of relationship building among staff was identified as a key concern, ensuring that employees experience job satisfaction in the workplace.

STUDENTS FEEDBACK ANALYSIS AND ACTION TAKEN REPORT 2020 - 21

Students feedback for the year 2020 - 21 and its analysis and action taken report

For collecting students feedback we targeted the students of all the classes of BA, BCom and BSc. Majority students were quite eager to register their responses in the feedback form. They were also asked five typical questions regarding the syllabus. The following questions were placed before them. They are as-

Firstly whether the syllabus includes interesting topics which is easy to understand, secondly whether syllabus is relevant to real life situation, thirdly whether syllabus is sufficient to make you capable to analyse the scientific, social or linguistic issues. The fourth question was on whether the syllabus is sufficient to promote ethical, moral and professional values. Again in the fifth question students were asked regarding the depth of the course content.

When we observe the analytical chart of of the feedback-data given by the students, we come across various views expressed by the students. In the first question 40% students were completely satisfied and 60% students were satisfied whereas the third and fourth alternatives were not addressed by the students. Here we have important suggestion from the students that the syllabus should have more interesting as it creates the healthy and happy atmosphere in learning process. Therefore the syllabus designer teachers are conveyed this message.

To the second question where the relevance of the syllabus to the real life was asked, 80% of the students expressed their complete satisfaction and only 20% students expressed their mere satisfaction.

When the students were asked about whether the syllabus is sufficient to make them analyse the scientific, social or linguistic issues, the responses of the students were little bit shocking. Because 0% students expressed their complete satisfaction whereas 80% students expressed their satisfaction on this issue. 10% students remain neutral whereas 10% students were not satisfied. In this regard teachers were asked to analyse the syllabus from scientific social and linguistic point of view so that students will get some knowledge about these issues.

To the fourth question, regarding the adequacy of syllabus to promote ethical moral and professional values, 40% students expressed their complete satisfaction and 60% students expressed mere satisfaction. Perhaps students are looking towards the syllabus of arts faculty expecting professional values to be taught through the syllabus, where they are not getting addressed. That's why we have this kind of response from the students. But 40% students have expressed their satisfaction on the same issue. On the same question 10% students are neutral and 10% students are dissatisfied on the issue raised in third question. Yet the expectation of the students are brought in the notice of the teachers of all the faculties. So they can address to the issue in teaching learning process.

On the issue of depth of course content, here also we see students divided. Because 60% of the students do find depth in the course content with complete satisfaction whereas 40% students are merely satisfied. Regarding this issue also the feedback committee decided to convey the students concern to the syllabus designers and the members of BOS of our college.

TEACHER'S FEEDBACK ANALYSIS AND ACTION TAKEN REPORT 2020-21

In the academic year 2020 and 21 the feedback from teachers were collected by the feedback committee. They were given the five questions in the form and their responses were demanded with that questioner. There are 16 teachers in our college working as full time teachers and one of them is holding the post of principal of our college hence 15 teachers where targeted for the feedback. The following questions were asked to the teachers. They are as -

- 1. The courses /syllabi taught by me have a good balance between theory and application,
- 2. The objectives of the syllabus are well defined.
- 3. Infrastructural facilities are available in the college.
- 4. The college provides adequate opportunities and support to faculty members for upgrading their skills and qualifications.
- 5. The environment in the college is conducive to teaching and research.

To these questions the following responses were registered by the teacher fraternity as feedback of the academic year 2020 -21.

After the analysis of above questions' responses given by the teachers, we have come to the conclusions as below.

To the first question 73.33% teachers expressed their full satisfaction whereas 26.6% expressed their mere satisfaction, none of others expressed neutral and dissatisfaction for the point mentioned in first question.

For the second question 80% of the teachers expressed their full satisfaction and 20% expressed satisfaction for the third question 60% teachers expressed their full satisfaction and 40% teachers expressed their satisfaction whereas 86.66% teachers expressed their full satisfaction and 13.33% teachers expressed their satisfaction for providing adequate opportunities and support from the management.

To the fifth question regarding the environment in the college 66% teachers expressed their full satisfaction and 20% teachers expressed near satisfaction but 13.33% teachers expressed their neutral attitude towards the fifth question.

Though the feedback of teachers for all the five questions are quite satisfactory yet they are said to maintain the good balance between the theory and application also they are asked to achieve the objectives defined by the syllabus designers. As infrastructural facilities are very well in the institution the faculty members are expected that they should utilise them as much as possible and utilise them in the teaching learning process.

EMPLOYERS FEEDBACK ANALYSIS AND ACTION TAKEN REPORT YEAR - 2020-2021

For the feedback of employers of this institution, they were asked five questions on various points. The first question was regarding the working as part of a team, second question was whether there is planning and organisation skill of faculty, in the third question their ability to use new technology and workplace equipment was focused, in the fourth question they were asked about the ability to contribute the goal of the organisation. In the last question the management was asked the relationship with seniors peers or subordinate.

On these different questions the employers reacted differently. One thing is clear that on the point whether the faculty works as a team, or of them where highly satisfied. About planning and organisation skill of the faculty 60% of the employers where highly satisfied and 40% of employers wear satisfied. On the issue of ability to use new technology and workplace equipment 100% employers where satisfied and 60% management was highly satisfied for the contribution of employers for achieving the goal of the organisation. When they were asked about the relationship between the employers and employees 40% employers were highly satisfied and 40% employers were just satisfied 20% of employers where neutral.

After looking towards the above reactions of employers it can be concluded that regarding planning and organisation skill of the faculty has to be improved. Also the ability of using new technology and the available facilities of the organisation employees have to be improved themselves in larger extent.

Therefore now it is necessary for stepping forward for doing improvements in the area of planning and organisation skill, ability of using technology and workplace equipments, ability to contribute to the goals of organisation and also the relationship between the employees and employers.

EMPLOYERS FEEDBACK ANALYSIS AND ACTION TAKEN REPORT YEAR - 2021-22

This is the analytical report and action taken report of the feedback collected from employers of this institution for the year 2021-2022. In this year also the employers were asked five questions regarding the ability of faculty members in different areas.

They were asked following questions:

- · Working as a part of team of the faculty
- · Planning and organisation skill of the faculty
- Ability to use new technology and workplace equipments.
- · Ability to contribute to the goals of the organisation
- And relationship with seniors peers and subordinates.

80% of the employers expressed their highly satisfied option and 20% of the employers choose satisfied. In the second question also 80% of the employees chose the option of highly satisfied and 20% of the employers chose just satisfied. Regarding the third question there was drastic division in the expressions of employers as 20% were highly satisfied 40% were satisfied and 40% were dissatisfied. In the fourth question 40% of the employers were highly satisfied and 20% were satisfied whereas 40% of employers were neutral. In the fifth question 80% employers wear highly satisfied and 20% employers were neutral.

After analysis of the above expressions of the employers, we have enough scope to decide about the future steps. Regarding the third question the employers have expressed their concern about the ability of using new technology and available equipments in their teaching learning process. Therefore it is necessary to train and motivate the faculty members for becoming ICT friendly in there teaching methods. For this if it is necessary to organise the workshop, the management will co-operate them. Also as the employers have given 40% expression for the ability to contribute for achieving goals of the institution, the faculties needed to be boosted to work more in this field also. Therefore the counselling is required part the employees of the organisation.

STUDENTS FEEDBACK ANALYSIS AND ACTION TAKEN REPORT 2021 - 22

The students feedback analysis and action taken report for the academic year 2021-22

In the academic year 2021-22, the feedback committee collected the responses of the students from all the departments and programs. The questions which were asked last year on the evaluation of the syllabus, the same pattern was kept before them in the form of feedback form, which different teachers collected from random students of our college. As usual their responses were different to all the questions. Their analysis is as below.

When the students were asked the first question regarding the interestingness of the topic and easiness to understand, 20% students were fully satisfied and 60% student were satisfied. 20% students were neutral and 0% students were unsatisfied.

Looking towards the above response all the heads of the departments were conveyed the concern of the students. Because only 20% students being completely satisfied is a matter of worry so the teachers are given the responsibility to make the syllabus more interesting and comfortable to understand when they are teaching in the classes.

40% students expressed their complete satisfaction about the relevance of the syllabus to the real life situation and the same percentage of the students were satisfied. 20% students remained neutral on this issue.

Here also looking towards the percentage of the students 40-40%, in first and second option, It needs worked on so that majority students should understand the relevance of their syllabus.

In the third question when the students were asked whether the syllabus is sufficient to make them analyse the scientific, social and linguistic issues, 60% students expressed their complete satisfaction whereas 20% students were satisfied. 20% of them remained neutral and 0% of the students were unsatisfied.

Looking towards the above percentage which is divided in variety, express a little bit concern that the students should understand the adequacy of the syllabus which should make them capable to analyse scientific social and linguistic issues. Only 60% is not sufficient figure though it is more than half of the students. So the teachers who are related with the students, are expected and clearly mentioned to them that they should bring the core of the syllabus to the students, and squeeze out the adequacy of the syllabus and bring them to the notice of the students while they discuss the various topics in the classrooms.

When the students were asked the fourth question whether the syllabus is sufficient to promote ethical, moral and professional values, 60% students expressed their complete satisfaction and 20% students were satisfied. But at the same time 20% students expressed their dissatisfaction.

Here also the teachers related to this students who are teaching in the classrooms, are given the directions that they should bring out the teachings of the syllabus where ethical moral and professional values are promoted. Students should get clear idea about the above lessons which percolate through the syllabus.

When students were asked a fifth question regarding the depth of the course content 40% students expressed their full satisfaction and 60% students expressed mere satisfaction about the depth of the course content.

In this regard the teachers are asked to rise the figure 40% more than 60%. We should get more than 60% students getting understood the depth of the course content with which the teaching skill of the teacher is directly related.

ANALYSIS AND ACTION TAKEN REPORT 2021-22

In the academic year 2021 - 2022 the feedback of alumni was collected and it was analysed. According to the data which we have collected and analysed give some indications for the improvement in the functioning of college. They are as below.

- 1. The response of alumni to the first question that the relevance of content of curriculum with current job and occupation, 60% alumni expressed their full satisfaction and 30% alumni were satisfied and just 10% where neutral about the question.
- 2. 70% of alumni were highly satisfied with the infrastructure laboratories and library facilities available in the college just 20% were satisfied and 10% where neutral about the question.
- 3. To the third question regarding arrangements of guest lectures in the college, alumni expressed 60% full satisfaction, 20% satisfaction, 10% of them were neutral and 10% of them where unsatisfied.
- 4. The fourth point was about cooperation from teachers, library, and office staff. To this question 64% members were fully satisfied whereas 26% where satisfied. On the other hand just 10% were neutral and none of them wear unsatisfied.
- 5. The responses of alumni to the fifth question that teaching faculties available in the college here also they there was 48% positive responses 42% where satisfied and 8% were neutral and 2% alumni where unsatisfied.

Looking towards the responses given by alumni, related departments were given the directions for necessary improvements as expected by the alumni. Members of faculty of our college were given the directions that whenever they will give their feedback and suggestions for syllabus design, they should give their valuable suggestions regarding job-oriented syllabus so that students will get benefit of their education.

Actually the infrastructure of our college is more than enough yet as alumni is expecting more improvements in lab, library facilities of our college, the point would be taken into consideration with serious concern. And suggestions would be passed to the management and the principal of our college.

Cooperative staff may it be teaching faculty or library or not teaching department, their being cooperative with each other and students is most necessary, so the required suggestions will be conveyed to the teaching, non teaching and library department for being cooperative to each other and also most importantly to the students who are the real stakeholders of the institution.

48% alumni members were fully satisfied and 42% were satisfied about the teachers availability in the college. Yet necessary directions will be conveyed to the employees of the institution for being present in the campus in their duty hours.

TEACHER'S FEEDBACK ANALYSIS AND ACTION TAKEN REPORT 2021-22

Feedback committee collected feedback from teachers group for the year 2021-22.

They were asked five questions regarding the syllabus, the objectives of the syllabus, infrastructure, the opportunities provided by the management and the environment in the college.

15 faculty members were participated in the feedback collection and they give their responses to the feedback committee. According to their data of feedback, there are various expressions in the analysis of the data given by them. We can conclude them in the following paragraph.

Regarding the relevance of syllabus and its balance between the application and theory 33.33 and 66.66% teachers expressed their complete satisfaction and satisfaction. Whereas regarding the objectives of syllabus whether they are well defined or not 80% faculty members expressed their complete satisfaction and 20% teachers were satisfied. The views of teachers regarding the infrastructural facilities provided in the college, 60% teachers were completely satisfied whereas 40% teachers were satisfied. When they were asked about the adequate opportunities and support to the faculty members for upgrading their skills and qualifications, 60% faculty members were fully satisfied and 40% teachers were satisfied.

When teachers were asked about how was the environment in the college 40% teachers wear completely satisfied and 40% teachers were merely satisfied whereas 20% teachers were expressed their inability to give their views on this topic.

After the keen analysis of the above percentage given for each question we can conclude that 33.33% of the teachers were fully satisfied it means remaining teachers are not happy with the frame of the syllabus. Therefore we can suggest to our professors who are working in BOS and who are suggesting their topics for syllabus design to upgrade the syllabus according to the expectations of the time and the opportunities which are before the students. The syllabus should be capable for justifying the needs of today's student hence teachers should take care while the syllabus is getting designed.

After the design of syllabus whatever objectives are put forth are achieved by the teachers and the students. We can come to this conclusion as 80% of the teachers are satisfied completely with this point.

As the institution provides majority satisfying infrastructural facilities, the teachers are expected to utilise them completely so that they will be capable to give adequate academic guidance to their students. And this message is clearly given to the teacher fraternity.

The teachers of the college are expected to work on various committees so that they can get equal opportunity to work on various responsibilities so that they can sharpen their abilities and skills. Even they are given the equal opportunity for doing academic growth, going to FDP, refresher courses, orientation programs etc.

Looking towards the responses given to the fifth question 40% teachers are fully satisfied and 40% teachers are just satisfied on the issue of environment in the college which is supportive for teaching and research. On this important issue the principal and the management have been conveyed these responses, so that they can bring the change more supportive for the teachers.
